ด้วยองค์การยูเนสโกได้มีไปรษณีย์อิเล็กทรอนิกส์แจ้งเกี่ยวกับรางวัล ESD Okayama Award 2023 ซึ่งได้รับการสนับสนุนโดยเมืองโอกายามะและคณะกรรมการขับเคลื่อน ESD Okayama Award ตั้งแต่ปี ค.ศ. ๒๐๑๕ โดยมีวัตถุประสงค์เพื่อยกย่องกิจกรรม ESD ที่มีความโดดเด่นในประเทศญี่ปุ่นและต่างประเทศ และส่งเสริม ESD ด้วยการจัดกิจกรรมดังกล่าวให้เป็นที่รู้จักอย่างแพร่หลาย โดยมีรายละเอียดดังนี้

๑. หน่วยงานที่มีโครงการด้าน ESD สามารถเสนอโครงการจำนวน ๑ รายการ เพื่อเข้าชิงรางวัล ESD Okayama Award โดยจะต้องเป็นโครงการที่ให้ความรู้และพัฒนาประชาชนให้เรียนรู้ซึ่งกันและกัน และ มีการลงมือปฏิบัติเพื่อนำไปสู่การสร้างสังคมที่ยั่งยืนจากมุมมองที่หลากหลาย เช่น การอนุรักษ์สิ่งแวดล้อม การพัฒนาชุมชน การสืบทอดมรดกทางประเพณีวัฒนธรรม และความหลากหลายและความครอบคลุม ฯลฯ รวมทั้งเป็นโครงการที่ดำเนินการอย่างต่อเนื่องอย่างน้อย ๒ ปี ณ เดือนเมษายน ๒๕๖๖

๒. กรรมการผู้เชี่ยวชาญจะคัดเลือกโครงการที่โดดเด่นและสามารถเป็นตัวอย่างในระดับโลก เพื่อนำไปสู่การส่งเสริม ESD ในชุมชนท้องถิ่นต่อไป จำนวน ๑-๒ รายการ ซึ่งแต่ละโครงการจะได้รับรางวัล ๓,๐๐๐ ดอลลาร์สหรัฐ นอกจากนี้ ผู้แทนหน่วยงานของโครงการที่ได้รับรางวัลจะได้รับเชิญให้เข้าร่วม การนำเสนอเกี่ยวกับโครงการในพิธีมอบรางวัล ESD Okayama Award ซึ่งมีกำหนดจัดขึ้นในวันพฤหัสบดีที่ ๒๓ พฤศจิกายน ๒๕๖๖ ณ เมืองโอกายามะ ประเทศญี่ปุ่น

ESD Okayama Award 2023Application Guide

To solve various problems we face, such as climate change, biodiversity and poverty, and to realize a society in which current and future generations can live in peace, Education for Sustainable Development (ESD), which promotes learning and practice to change conventional values, thinking and behavior, has been introduced in many parts of the world. In order to facilitate action to build sustainable societies around the world, the 17 global goals of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) were created in the 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda, which was adopted in September 2015 at the UN Summit. Since education is the key to achieving the SDGs, the new international framework of ESD, "ESD for 2030", started in January 2020. ESD is expected to be further promoted to create a sustainable society.

In Okayama, Japan, the Okayama ESD Promotion Commission, the network of the diverse stakeholders promoting ESD in the area (secretariat at Okayama City Office), was established in 2005, in conjunction with the launch of "The UN Decade of ESD", and its Okayama ESD Project was created. Okayama City has played a leading role in accelerating collaborative actions among people working for ESD. One of the remarkable events was to host the Stakeholder Meetings of the UNESCO World Conference on ESD in 2014.

In 2015, Okayama city launched the ESD Okayama Award to actively promote ESD and contribute to ESD around the world. The ESD Okayama Award is held annually by Okayama City and the ESD Okayama Award Steering Board consisting of organizations which have contributed to the promotion of ESD in Japan and around the world. By recognizing outstanding examples of ESD in Japan and abroad, the ESD Okayama Award aims to contribute to the visualization and dissemination of ESD, to help organizations implementing ESD projects to enhance their activities, and to contribute to the achievement of the SDGs.

**Projects eligible for this award are ongoing and have been running for at least two years as of April 2023. Projects in the planning stages are not eligible.

XThe organizations that have won the ESD Okayama Award in the past cannot apply with the award-winning projects, but can apply with other projects.

Selection Criteria

The ESD Okayama Award will be given to outstanding projects that can serve as global models contributing to promotion of ESD in local communities. Submitted projects will be reviewed by ESD experts based on the following criteria:

Vision	The project outlines local issues to realize a sustainable society, and objectives are clearly stated.
Collaboration	The project has a clear implementation structure with various collaborating stakeholders (individuals and organizations).
Integration	The project integrates economic, environmental, and social dimensions.
Innovation	The project demonstrates innovative approaches and methods to promote ESD.
Status of	The project has a track record of activities and documentations including feedback and
Implementation	evaluation of audiences and stakeholders.
Empowerment	The project takes educational approaches such as interactive methods for problem-solving and promoting actions to shape a sustainable future. The project also leads to behavior change of individuals, including the transformation of values, attitudes and actions, and to the empowerment of local communities.
Future Strategy	The project is expected to be expanded in the future and bring positive influences to other communities as well.
